A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER. PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) NO. 2018-097-KB FOR CITYWIDE GEOTECHNICAL AND LABORATORY TESTING SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS: AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH RADISE INTERNATIONAL, LC, AS THE TOP RANKED PROPOSER; PROFESSIONAL SERVICE INDUSTRIES, INC., AS THE SECOND RANKED PROPOSER; GFA INTERNATIONAL. INC., AS THE THIRD RANKED PROPOSER: UNIVERSAL ENGINEERING SCIENCES, INC. AS THE FOURTH RANKED PROPOSER; TERRACON CONSULTANTS, INC., AS THE FIFTH RANKED PROPOSER; NUTTING ENGINEERS OF FLORIDA, INC. AND WOOD ENVIRONMENT & INC. SIXTH INFRASTRUCTURE SOLUTIONS. AS THE RANKED PROPOSERS: WINGERTER LABORATORIES, AS THE EIGHTH RANKED PROPOSER; AND TIERRA SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. AS THE NINTH RANKED PROPOSERS: AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH EACH OF THE FOREGOING PROPOSERS UPON CONCLUSION OF SUCCESSFUL NEGOTIATIONS BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2018, the City Commission approved to issue the City Commission approved to issue the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) NO. 2017-097-KB, for citywide geotechnical and laboratory testing services on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, Request for Qualifications No. 2018-097-KB (the "RFQ") was released on April 12, 2018; and

WHEREAS, a voluntary pre-proposal meeting was held on April 25, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2018, the City received a total of nine (9) proposals; and

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2018 and September 10, 2018, an Evaluation Committee ("Committee") appointed by the City Manager, via Letter to Commission (LTC) No. 454-2018, convened to consider the responsive proposals received; and

WHEREAS, the Committee was provided an overview of the project, information relative to the City's Cone of Silence Ordinance and the Government Sunshine Law, general information on the scope of services, and a copy of each proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Committee's ranking was as follows: RADISE International, LC, as the top ranked proposer; Professional Service Industries, Inc., as the second ranked proposer; GFA International, Inc., as the third ranked proposer; Universal Engineering Sciences, Inc, as the fourth ranked proposer; Terracon Consultants, Inc., as the fifth ranked proposer; Nutting Engineers of Florida, Inc. and Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc, as the sixth ranked proposers; Wingerter Laboratories, as the eighth ranked proposer; and Tierra South Florida, Inc. as the ninth ranked proposers; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all the submissions and the results of the evaluation process, the City Manager recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve the resolution authorizing the Administration to enter into negotiations with RADISE International,

LC, as the top ranked proposer; Professional Service Industries, Inc., as the second ranked proposer; GFA International, Inc., as the third ranked proposer; Universal Engineering Sciences, Inc, as the fourth ranked proposer; Terracon Consultants, Inc., as the fifth ranked proposer; Nutting Engineers of Florida, Inc. and Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc, as the sixth ranked proposers; Wingerter Laboratories, as the eighth ranked proposer; and Tierra South Florida, Inc. as the ninth ranked proposers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager, pursuant to Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 2018-097-KB, for Citywide Geotechnical and Laboratory Testing Services on an As-Needed Basis; authorize the Administration to enter into negotiations with RADISE International, LC, as the top ranked proposer; Professional Service Industries, Inc., as the second ranked proposer; GFA International, Inc., as the third ranked proposer; Universal Engineering Sciences, Inc, as the fourth ranked proposer; Terracon Consultants, Inc., as the fifth ranked proposer; Nutting Engineers of Florida, Inc. and Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc, as the sixth ranked proposers; Wingerter Laboratories, as the eighth ranked proposer; and Tierra South Florida, Inc. as the ninth ranked proposers; and further authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute agreements with each of the foregoing proposers upon conclusion of successful negotiations by the Administration.
