**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD AN AGREEMENT, PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 2018-001-KB, FOR WATER, SANITARY, STORM AND STREET LIGHT UTILITY LOCATING SERVICES TO THE TOP RANKED PROPOSER, USIC LOCATING SERVICES, LLC; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH USIC LOCATING SERVICES, LLC, SUBJECT TO AND CONTINGENT UPON AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, AT THE CITY COMMISSION'S SOLE DISCRETION.**

**WHEREAS**, on May 16, 2018, the Mayor and City Commission authorized the issuance of Request for Proposals (RFP) 2018-001-KB for water, sanitary, storm and street light utility locating services; and

**WHEREAS**, RFP responses were due and received on July 30, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the City received proposals in response to the RFP from the following four (4) firms: Craig A. Smith & Associates, Inc., High Tech Engineering, Inc., USIC Locating Services, LLC, Venegroup Engineering; and

**WHEREAS**, an Evaluation Committee appointed by the City Manager pursuant to LTC# 492-2018 convened on September 19, 2018, to consider the responsive proposals received; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee was provided an overview of the project, information relative to the City's Cone of Silence Ordinance and the Government Sunshine Law, general information on the scope of services and a copy of each proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee was instructed to score and rank each proposal pursuant to the evaluation criteria established in the RFP; and

**WHEREAS**, the evaluation process resulted in the ranking of proposers as follows: USIC Locating Services, LLC, was the top ranked proposer, Craig A. Smith & Associates, Inc. as the second ranked proposer, Venegroup Engineering as the third ranked proposer, and High Tech Engineering, Inc. as the fourth ranked proposer; and

**WHEREAS**, after reviewing all of the submissions and the Evaluation Committee's rankings and commentary, based on the best overall combination of experience/qualifications and cost, the City Manager has recommended that the Mayor and City Commission award the RFP to USIC Locating Services, LLC, subject to funds availability if approved through the City's budgeting process.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager to award an agreement, pursuant to Request for Proposals (RFP) 2018-001-KB for Water, Sanitary, Storm and Street Light Utility Locating Services, to the top-ranked proposer, USIC Locating Services, LLC; and further authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement with USIC Locating

Services, LLC., subject to and contingent upon an appropriation of funds, at the City Commission's sole discretion.
