<u>Brief Scope:</u> The purpose of this Agreement is to retain sea-towing contractors for the removal and disposal of derelict vessels.		
<u>Justification:</u> The City has not needed these contractors to provide services to the City during the initial term of the Agreement. However, the Police Department has recommended the renewal of the Agreements to ensure that, in the event the need arises, navigation hazards are removed safely from the City's waterways. This is the final renewal option available for these contracts. Subsequently, the Procurement Department anticipates issuing a competitive solicitation for these services so that a replacement contract can be established. The RFP is currently being developed with the assistance of Tidal Basin Government Consulting, the City's emergency administrative support consultant, to comply with any FEMA requirements and guidelines. Therefore, it is the best interest to the City to extend the Agreement for an additional one (1) year period as the City may need these services before a replacement contract can be established.

<u>Contractor</u> Parkmobile USA, Inc.	<u>Extended Through</u> February 23, 2020	
<u>Brief Scope:</u> The purpose of this Agreement is to provide an electronic payment option via an app to the City's parking customers.		
<u>Justification:</u> The Parkmobile payment application (app) facilitates electronic payment of parking transactions to City's parking customers, including residents. Despite the presence of other parking payment app providers in neighboring municipalities, Parkmobile was selected, in part, because it was the only firm that an established methodology for offering discount rates to residents through its app. While other vendors who responded to the RFP could have developed (that would have had to have been tested), Parkmobile already had one deployed and the City was able to document that it was working well. The Parking Department has recommended the renewal of the Agreement to ensure the continuation of the current app functionality that has been working well.

Brief Scope: The purpose of this ITB was to establish a contract to provide all materials, labor, applicable fees and permits for routine and emergency repairs for water, sanitary sewer and storm water pipe break; cured-in place lining for sanitary sewer pipes and storm water pipes; and rehabilitation of sanitary sewer manholes and storm water manholes.	
Justification: The services pursuant to this Agreement have not been required by the Public Works Department over the last year. The Procurement Department is currently working with the Public Works Department to modify specifications to the City's current needs and issue an Invitation to Bid (ITB) to establish a replacement contract for these services. In the interim, the Public Works Sewer Department has recommended extending these Agreements in case the services are needed prior to the award of a new contract.
