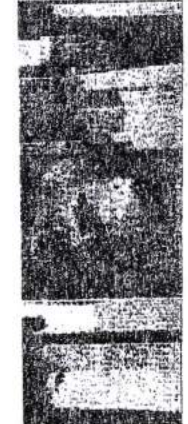
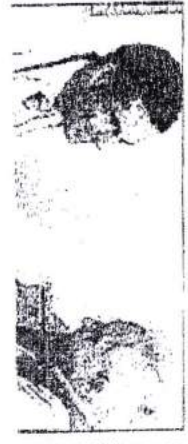
If you work anywhere in South Florida, the name Oscar Lorente is as familiar as the Atlantic beaches along our sun-drenched coastline.

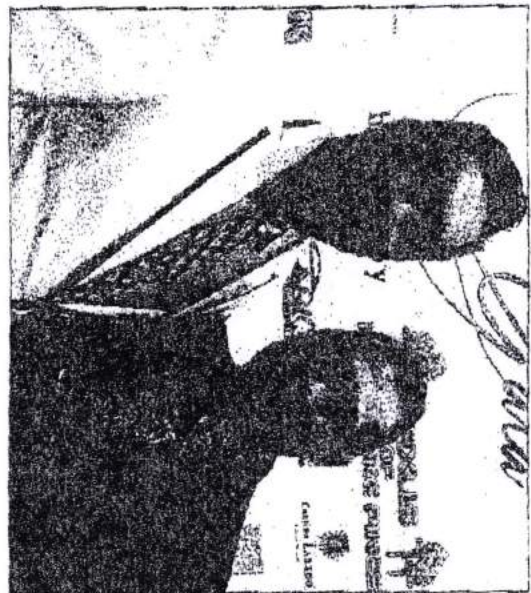

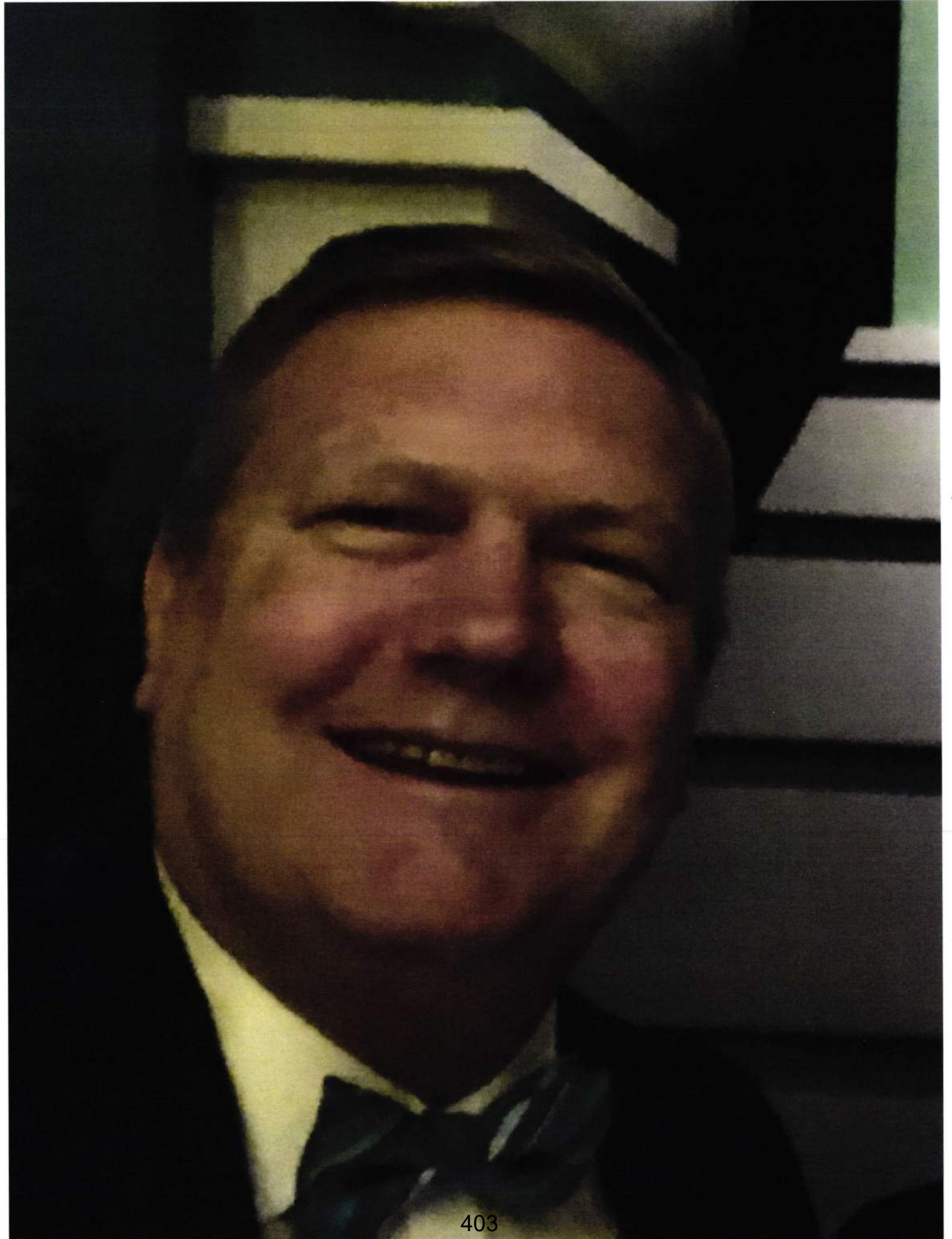
