

Greetings:

This letter of interest is being submitted for consideration to fill the current vacancy on the City Commission, Group IV.

For the past five years I have been a resident of Miami Beach. I am retired after a fulfilling career in education and technology. After attending many workshops in the city regarding public building and funding projects, transportation, energy usage and condominium regulation I am impressed with the degree of interaction the city has with its citizenry. I see this current vacancy on the commission as an opportunity to increase my involvement significantly.

A brief summary of my professional career would include over thirty five years in education as a teacher, adjunct professor, technology coordinator, administator, grant writer, innovator, coach and data consultant.

Memorable accomplishments would be the design, constructon and implementation of the first computer lab with curriculum at the University of Massachussetts, Lowell. We handled five hundred students a semester while offering the entire course online in 1981.

Later I helped Newfound Area School District in New Hampshire establish their technology from 1984 to the mid 1990s. This linked seven schools and the central office in professional and educational use of technology. Most of this was paid for by state and federal grants that I had written.

Prior to moving to New Hampshire I attained a Master's Degree in Energy Engineering which focussed on nuclear engineering with in-depth instruction in solar, wind and geothermal.

As to how this all would transfer to the commission, I offer that my background in energy would help the city to understand what is happening with Turkey Point, electrical usage in the city and pursue additional methods of local energy production. This could relate to the management of water here in Miami Beach.

In New Hampshire I was very closely involved in the management of the district budget (15-20 million dollars) both in compilation and disbursement.

The present Miami Beach is vibrant and healthy. The future version of the city is being challenged by the environment, population, construction and transportation. I am willing to put in the time to understand and confront these issues. I believe I have the talents and skills to work with the commission and be directed so that the city benefits.
