JEFFREY A. RYNOR is a founding member of Mitrani, Rynor, Adamsky & Toland, P.A., who practices in matrimonial and civil litigation where he is also a certified family mediator. He earned his law degree from the University of Florida in 1980 and received an LL.M. degree in Taxation from George Washington University in 1982. He received his undergraduate degree, with high honors and Phi Beta Kappa distinction, from the University of Florida in 1978.

Mr. Rynor has been named one of South Florida's "Top Lawyers" in the areas of civil litigation and matrimonial law in the "South Florida Legal Guide" and named one of Florida's Super Lawyers.
