A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER, PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS NO. 2018-016-KB, FOR MAPPING AND SURVEYING SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH LONGITUDE SURVEYORS, LLC, THE TOP RANKED PROPOSER; FURTHER, SHOULD THE ADMINISTRATION NOT BE SUCCESSFUL IN NEGOTIATING AN AGREEMENT WITH LONGITUDE SURVEYORS, LLC, AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH BISCAYNE ENGINEERING COMPANY, INC., THE SECOND RANKED PROPOSER; FURTHER. SHOULD THE ADMINISTRATION NOT BE SUCCESSFUL IN NEGOTIATING AN AGREEMENT WITH BISCAYNE ENGINEERING COMPANY, INC., AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH MANUEL G. VERA & ASSOCIATES, INC., THE THIRD RANKED PROPOSER; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT UPON CONCLUSION OF SUCCESSFUL NEGOTIATIONS BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2018, the City Commission approved the issuance of Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 2019-016-KB for Mapping and Surveying Services; and

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2018, the RFQ was issued; and

WHEREAS, RFQ responses were due and received December 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City received proposals from the following thirteen (13) firms: Craig A Smith & Associates, Inc., Maser Consulting P.A., CSA Central, Inc., Longitude Surveyors, LLC, Biscayne Engineering Company Inc., Atkins North America, Inc., Miller Legg & Associates, Inc., Manuel G. Vera & Associates, Inc., HBK Engineering, LLC, F.R Aleman and Associates, Inc., Haddone, Corp., Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc., and Woolpert, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, CSA Central, Inc. withdrew its proposal response prior to the evaluation committee meeting and received no further consideration; and

WHEREAS, an Evaluation Committee ("Committee") appointed by the City Manager pursuant to LTC# 643-2018 convened on January 23, 2019 and January 24, 2019, to consider the responsive proposals received; and

WHEREAS, the Committee was provided an overview of the project, information relative to the City's Cone of Silence Ordinance, the Government Sunshine Law and general information on the scope of services and a copy of each proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Committee was instructed to score and rank each proposal pursuant to the evaluation criteria established in the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation process resulted in the ranking of proposers as follows: Longitude Surveyors, LLC, as the first ranked proposer; Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc., as the second ranked proposer, and Manuel G. Vera & Associates, Inc., as the third ranked proposer; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all of the submissions and the Evaluation Committee's rankings, the City Manager exercised his due diligence and is recommending that the Administration be authorized to enter into negotiations with Longitude Surveyors, LLC, as the top ranked proposer, and further, should the Administration not be successful in negotiating an agreement with Longitude Surveyors, LLC; authorizing the Administration to enter into negotiations with Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc., as the second ranked proposer; and further, should the Administration not be successful in negotiating an agreement with Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc., authorizing the Administration to enter into negotiations with Manuel G. Vera & Associates, Inc., as the third ranked proposer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager, pursuant to Request for Qualifications No 2019-016-KB, for Mapping and Surveying Services; authorize the Administration to enter into negotiations with Longitude Surveyors, LLC, the top ranked proposer; further, should the Administration not be successful in negotiating an agreement with Longitude Surveyors, LLC; authorize the Administration to enter into negotiations with Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc., the second ranked proposer; further, should the Administration not be successful in negotiating an agreement with Biscayne Engineering Company, Inc., authorize the Administration to enter into negotiations with Manuel G. Vera & Associates, Inc., the third ranked proposer; and further authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement upon conclusion of successful negotiations by the Administration.
