INTERIOR OF TYPICAL HOTEL ROOM

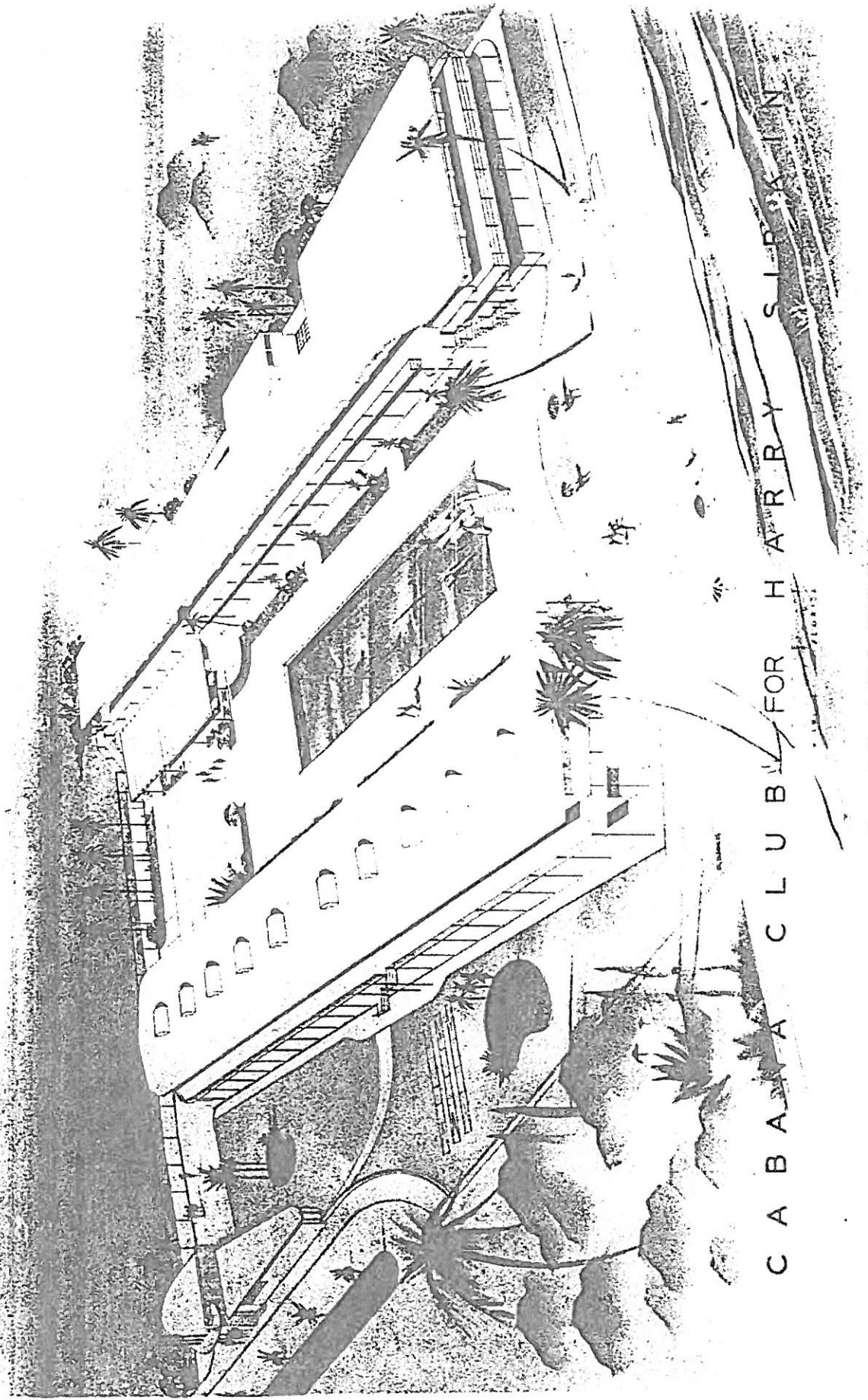

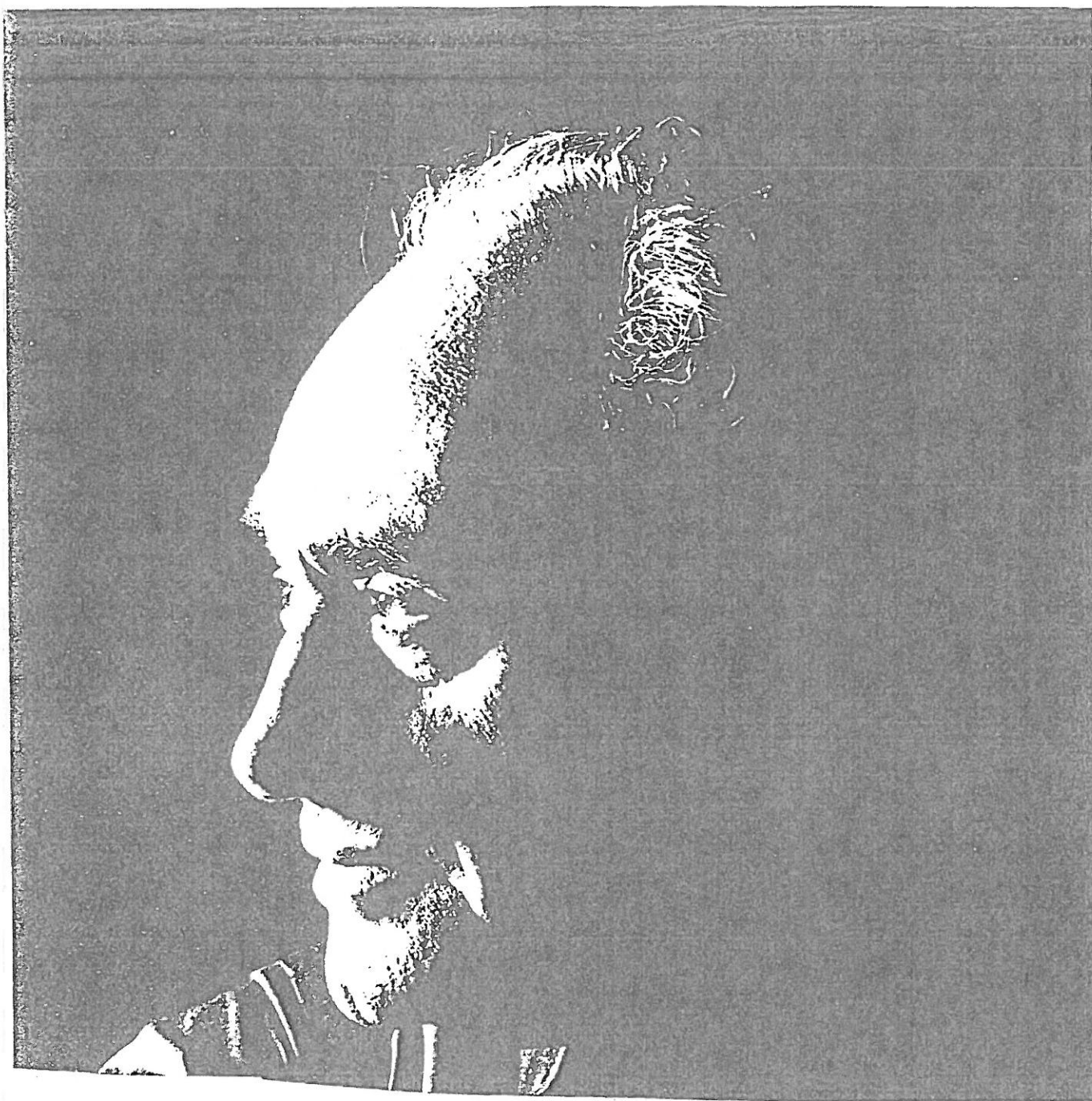
