

BPAC RESOLUTION #13-2019

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH 23RD STREET
COMPLETE STREETS PLAN AS PART OF THE CITY'S
TRANSPORTATION GOALS**

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement creating and establishing the Miami-Dade Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), for the Miami Urbanized Area, now known as the Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), requires that the TPO provide a structure to evaluate the adequacy of the transportation planning and programming process; and

WHEREAS, the TPO has established the Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) to advise it on bicycle and pedestrian related plans and projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach Transportation Master Plan has ranked Mode Share on its streets as (1) Pedestrians; (2) Transit, Bicycles, Freight; and (3) Private Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach Transportation Master Plan has adopted a network of multimodal improvements and 23rd Street is a critical link in the network; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach has a goal to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by an estimated 9.2 metric tons per day, and multimodal improvements are an important way to reduce greenhouse gases; and

WHEREAS, the BPAC supports the goals of the City of Miami Beach to reduce Traffic Congestion, Improve Safety; and to create an environment that is good for business,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BICYCLE PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE MIAMI-DADE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION that this committee supports the Miami Beach 23rd Street Complete Streets Plan as part of the City's transportation goals.
