A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE AT ITS MARCH 4, 2020 MEETING, TO IDENTIFY AND APPROVE FUNDING TO BE USED TO ENHANCE LIGHTING AT BELLE ISLE PARK.

WHEREAS, at the February 12, 2020 meeting, the Mayor and City Commission approved a referral to the Neighborhoods and Quality of Life Committee to discuss lighting at Belle Isle Park and potential avenues for enhancement; and

**WHEREAS**, residents of Belle Isle have reported concerns regarding the lack of lighting at Belle Isle Park and corresponding safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, the City's Public Works Infrastructure Division staff have assessed lighting at Belle Isle Park and surrounding areas and made a few recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the project's estimated total cost is \$110,000, and the cost estimate for inhouse labor and other miscellaneous materials is \$31,221; and

**WHEREAS**, this item was presented to Neighborhood and Quality of Life Committee (the "Committee") meeting for further discussion at its March 4, 2020 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the need for enhanced lighting was acknowledged at the Committee and a motion was made: (1) to identify and approve funding to be used for this cause, (2) to provide notification to Belle Isle associations and residents, and to bring the item to the March 18, 2020 City Commission meeting for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the Neighborhood and Quality of Life Committee at its March 4, 2020 meeting, to identify and approve funding to be used to enhance lighting at Belle Isle Park.
