Dear Ms. Baglieri:

As a follow-up to our meeting of December 11th, and as per your request, following is our recommendation for stucco remediation for the above-noted projects. In formulating our recommendation, we have taken into consideration that this was an unknown condition, and as such, was not originally funded. We believe this to be the most cost effective solution.

- Recommendation/Scope of Work:
 - All delaminated and cracked stucco is to be mechanically removed down to substrate (masonry or concrete). Pre-formed control/expansion joints and corner beads shall also be removed.
 - The remaining suitable stucco is to be sandblasted to remove paint and to provide for a textured surface to increase bonding of new stucco.
 - Apply bonding agent to exposed masonry and concrete those areas where the stucco was removed down to the substrate and patch with stucco flush with the existing stucco to remain.
 - Apply a bonding coat over entire stucco area and apply a new, 3-coat, 5/8" total thickness coat of stucco with a float finish. Include the necessary control joints and apply a bead of sealant in the cavity of the joint to provide a flush surface (in the play surfaces only).
 - Prime and paint stucco after it has cured and the alkalinity and moisture content are within the limits established by the paint manufacturer.

EXHIBIT A

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The above recommendation is applicable to all stucco finished surfaces of the courts. The resulting product will visually resemble a new court wall surface and will not show the patching performed below the finish stucco.
