Nationwide, shared bike and scooter vendors have been working with local governments to tailor their response, increase the frequency of sanitation, and adapt their service boundaries to the areas with the most urgent transportation needs.

Here's a list of the free/discounted services companies have been offering in other cities:

- Citi/Lyft is offering free e-scooter and bike-share rides to healthcare workers, first responders and public transit employees in Chicago, New York, Boston, Austin, Denver, Los Angeles, San Diego, Santa Monica, and Washington, DC
- Revel is offering free rides to healthcare workers in New York, Oakland, Washington, D.C., and Austin
- Gruv is offering free rides to first responders, healthcare and grocery store workers in San Jose and Oakland
- Spin is offering free rides to first responders, healthcare and grocery store workers in Baltimore, Denver, Detroit, Los Angeles, Portland, San Francisco, Tampa, and Washington D.C
- Bird is offering free rides to healthcare and emergency workers in Santa Monica and Culver City
- Jump/Uber Is offering free rides to healthcare workers
