Aman Today


Today, embracing 32 properties in 20 countries, Aman continues to seek out transformative experiences and awe-inspiring locations around the world.



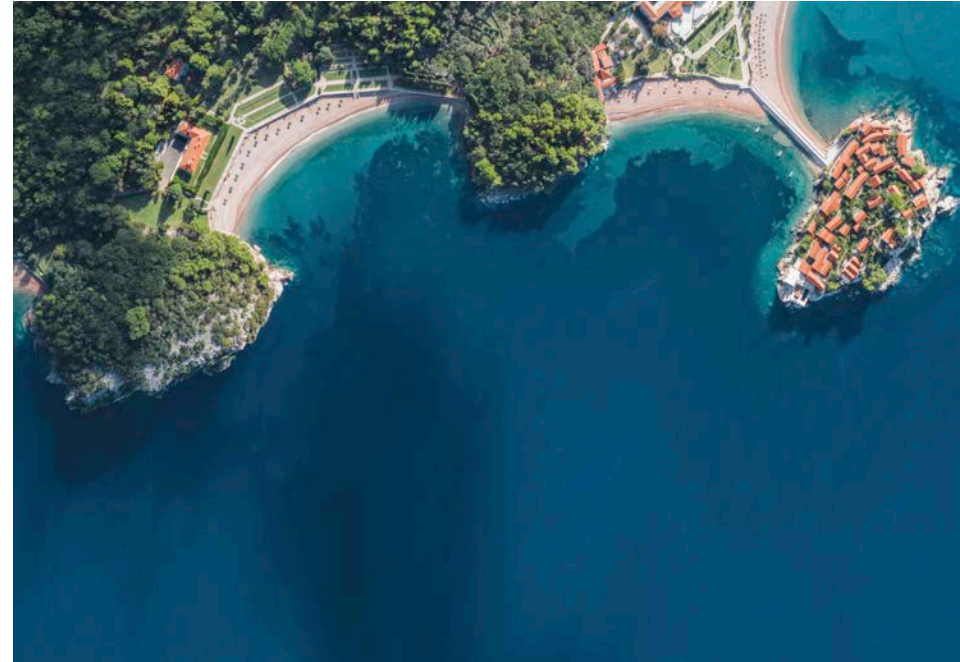
Set in the Crown Building, completed in 1921 and one of the finest examples of Beaux-Arts architecture in the United States



Aman Sveti Stefan



Housed in the 15th Century UNESCO-protected fishing village of Sveti Stefan, as well as Villa Milocer on the mainland, once the summer residence of Queen Marija Karadjordjevic



Aman Venice



Set in one of the city's eight, great monumental palazzos on the Grand Canal, the Palazzo Papadopoli, completed in 1570 with artworks by Tiepolo. The property was converted into a hotel by Jean Michel Gathy, opening in 2013



Aman Summer Palace



Housed in a series of dwellings at the Summer Palace in Beijing dating back over a century. The original complex was used by guests of the Summer Palace awaiting an audience with the Empress Dowager Cixi.



Amanyangyun



The culmination of an ambitious feat of architectural and ecological conservation, 13 re-mastered Ming and Qing Dynasty villas were carefully moved brick-by-brick from Fuzhou to become an integral part of Aman's fourth destination in China.
