Comments:

- 1. sheet A2.05 are the floor slabs really existing to remain. It was discussed that the floors slabs were at different heights.
 - The plans have been modified to show the entire floor slab on the ground floor to be removed because of the differing floor heights
- 2. sheet A2.15 the 955 building does not look correct in the rendering
 - The 955 building has been corrected in the rendering on sheet A2.15
- 3. provide details of the pool deck bar structure and all elevations. provide a line of sight diagram as this is a partial rooftop addition.
 - Elevations and a section have been provided, See sheet
- 4. provide a rendering of the pool deck area.
 - See vignettes of the pool deck area on sheet 2.19
- 5. confirm with FPL that the location of the vault room is acceptable
 - The size of the FPL room is the acceptable size. The location may be moved during the construction documents to the north side but we have not received final confirmation.
- 6. show location of BFP on site plan.
 - See Sheet A2.09 for back flow location
- 7. the mechanical equipment area on the roof seems undersized.
 See roof plan for VRF units at roof.
- 8. the level 2 landscaping plan and arch plan are not consistent at pool deck
 Architectural sheets were updated
- 9. confirm the mech green screen will survive.
 - Mechanical screen will consist of fluted terracotta panels as shown on A4.00, A4.01, A4.02, A4.03

Recommendation(s)

- 1. staff recommends elimination of the metal eyebrow
 - We would like to proceed with the metal eyebrow and have the board decide. It is very important to the owner for the presence of the hotel on Washington.
- 2. staff recommends that the column at the main entrance be engaged into the wall and not floating.
 - Rockwell to provide comments
- 3. staff recommends the storefront configurations be further studied to be more consistent with the historical configuration.
 - We added a wall behind the column so it is engaged in the wall.
