THE RHYTHM FOUNDATION has been presenting outstanding international music in Miami-Dade since 1988, and we look back at a body of work that now spans decades. When we began, Miami was a different place than the international crossroads we know now. It makes us proud to think our cultural and community-based programming have contributed in a meaningful way to the growth of our hometown.



In 2015, the City of Miami Beach awarded us the management of the North Beach Bandshell, a 1400-capacity oceanfront amphitheater. We had come full circle, but were now fully prepared to make our home in a historic venue. We launched a well-rounded schedule of 75+ events per year - a mix of free community and civic events, cultural programs, popular music and large productions - that welcome the entire South Florida and visitor community to the Bandshell. The management contract has been extended, and in 2020 the City has also undertaken much capital some needed improvements to the Bandshell including the installation of a weather canopy and improved seating.
