VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Inform students of the requirements to vote

- Students must be at least 16 years of age to register.
- **Students must be a citizen of the United States.**
- Students must reside in Miami-Dade County, Florida.
- PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS who **cannot** register to vote:
 - **Student is not a U.S. citizen.**
 - **Student has been adjudicated mentally incapacitated with respect to voting and has not had their right to vote restored.**
 - **Student has been convicted of a felony and has not had their civil rights restored.**

PLEASE NOTE:

Eligible students who do not have a Florida driver license or state identification card or social security number or who get an error attempting to complete the registration process, **can still use the website to complete their application but they will have to print, sign, and deliver it by mail or in-person to their county Supervisor of Elections office.**

IMPORTANT:

SCHOOLS SHOULD NOT COLLECT PRINTED VOTER REGISTRATION CARDS FROM STUDENTS WHO WERE NOT ABLE TO COMPLETE THE REGISTRATION PROCESS ONLINE AND TURN THEM IN TO THE ELECTIONS OFFICE. THIS MUST BE DONE BY THE STUDENT.



PREPARE STUDENTS FOR ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION

Prepare students to register to vote by making sure they have the following information for **ON THE DAY THEY WILL BE REGISTERING**:

1. A Florida driver license (students will need driver's license number) or a state ID card (need state ID #), and
2. The student's last 4 digits of their social security number.
3. Students must have access to a desk top computer, tablet, or mobile device.

step 3

INFORM STUDENTS ABOUT THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Tell students that they will see the following banner when they log onto the student portal.



2. Inform students that when they click on it, they will see the flyer shown on the next slide and that they are to read the flyer and follow the steps. **Make sure to stress that after students register, they need to click on the link found in "Step 3" to report that they registered so that your school gets credit.**

Register to Vote Flyer:

This is the flyer (to the right) the students will pull up once they click on the banner found in the Student Portal.

step 1

CHECK: ARE YOU ELIGIBLE TO REGISTER TO VOTE?

To register to vote, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Be a Florida resident.
- Be at least 16 years old (you can pre-register to vote at 16 years old, but you'll need to wait until you're 18 years old to vote).
- Have never been convicted of a felony (unless your civil rights have been restored).
- Have never been legally judged ineligible to vote, for either mental incapacitation or crime.
- **IF THIS IS YOU- SEE STEP 2- IF NOT, TELL YOUR ELIGIBLE FRIENDS TO REGISTER TO VOTE!**
