Dear Historic Preservation Board Members,

Please find a link below that contains videos from 2014, 2015, 2016, and May 6, 2022 . The videos from 2014-2016 illustrate the heavy congestion and chaos within the 100 block of 20<sup>th</sup> Street when The Shore Club was open. The most recent video from May 6, 2022, shows the traffic in that same block on 20<sup>th</sup> Street while The Shore Club is closed.

It is reasonable to believe that traffic in that area will be at least as congested, if not more, once The Shore Club is re-opened. 20<sup>th</sup> Street will be in disarray and over-crowded with deliveries, garbage trucks, residents, visitors, and beach goers utilizing 20<sup>th</sup> Street as a public beach access, which also causes great concern for the safety of those in that area. Specifically, response times for emergency services.

Additionally, there is a still photo of the area where The Townhouse keeps their dumpsters. The wall has been built along the property line, with The Shore Club property to the left of the wall. Another concern is where The Shore Club will place their dumpsters as there appears to be limited space.
