A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, ON BEHALF OF THE MIAMI BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND THE UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE, WHICH SERVES TO EXTEND THE PARTICIPATION OF THE MIAMI BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT, FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND APPREHENDING FUGITIVES IN AN EFFORT TO REDUCE VIOLENT CRIME.

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2000, the Presidential Threat Protection Act of 2000 was enacted to enable the United States Justice Department, through the United States Marshals Service, to establish permanent Regional Fugitive Task Forces consisting of Federal, state and local law enforcement agencies in designated regions of the United States; and

WHEREAS, a detective of the Miami Beach Police Department is assigned to the Regional Fugitive Task Force, and is working in conjunction with Federal, state and other local law enforcement personnel in locating and apprehending fugitives in the City of Miami Beach and South Florida; and

WHEREAS, it is a known fact that fugitives and persons who have active Federal and state arrest warrants frequent the South Florida area, including the City of Miami Beach; and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2010, the Miami Beach City Commission authorized the City Manager and City Clerk to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Miami Beach, on behalf of the Miami Beach Police Department, and the United States Marshals Service, which must now be renewed to allow the Miami Beach Police Department to continue as a member agency of the Regional Fugitive Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service will continue to provide the Miami Beach Police Department a vehicle that will be utilized by a detective of the Miami Beach Police Department, and will reimburse the Miami Beach Police Department for overtime costs consistent with the Fair Labor Standards Act, travel expenses and investigative costs that are incurred by the detective in locating and apprehending fugitives, pending the availability of funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach, on behalf of the Miami Beach Police Department, and the United States Marshals Service wish to extend the Memorandum of Understanding and the participation of the Miami Beach Police Department in the Regional Fugitive Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, hereby authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Miami Beach, on behalf of the Miami Beach Police Department, and the United States Marshals Service, which serves to extend the participation of the Miami Beach Police Department, for the purpose of locating and apprehending fugitives in an effort to reduce violent crime.
