Perhaps they think this is some spiritual event but the residents from Apogee, Portofino, South Pointe Tower and Continuum know this a unwanted very loud live music South of Fifth.

I can remember many years ago Frank DelVecchio stating that we have a prohibition of live music events in the park. This is just unregulated intrusive noise in the evening hours. When people call Code they say they are powerless to regulate.

What can we do? I believe you may have a topic on the Feb 1 agenda and when we asked the City attorney and Paz mentioned that the commission may have passed a pilot program for entertainment in South Point Park. If so, no one in the neighborhood was asked or told it was coming up for a vote including SOFNA. Can you help to clarify?
