Igor Polevitsky (1911-1978) was a South Florida-based architect, who emigrated from Russia to the USA in 1922. Mr. Polevitsky moved to Miami in 1934 after graduating from the University of Pennsylvania, and was responsible for the design of hotels, office buildings, and houses throughout South Florida and Cuba until the mid-1960s, when he retired to Colorado.
