NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on October 18, 2023, at 10:10 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, the Mayor and City Commissioners of the City of Miami Beach will hold a First Reading/Public Hearing on the following proposed Ordinance:

#### CENTURY LANE AND FARREY LANE OVERLAY DISTRICT - LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS (LDR)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE RESILIENCY CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 7, ENTITLED "ZONING DISTRICTS AND REGULATIONS," ARTICLE II, ENTITLED "DISTRICT REGULATIONS," AT SECTION 7.2.4, ENTITLED "RM-1 RESIDENTIAL MULTIFAMILY LOW INTENSITY," BY CREATING SUBSECTION 7.2.4.6, ENTITLED "CENTURY LANE AND FARREY LANE OVERLAY DISTRICT," TO PROVIDE SPECIFIC DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS FOR THE OVERLAY, INCLUDING AMENDING THE MAIN PERMITTED, PROHIBITED, AND CONDITIONAL USES, MODIFICATIONS TO THE LOT AGGREGATION REQUIREMENTS, AND INCLUSION DESIGN AND RESILIENCY STANDARDS; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, APPLICABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance is being heard pursuant to Chapter 2, Article IV of the Resiliency Code, Section 2.05 of the City Charter, and §166.041 F.S. If this proposed Ordinance is approved on First Reading, then on December 13, 2023, at 5:02 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, the Mayor and City Commissioners of the City of Miami Beach will hold a Second Reading/Public Hearing on the proposed Ordinance.
