## Florida Law Prohibits the Installation of Signs in the Public ROW . . . except for:

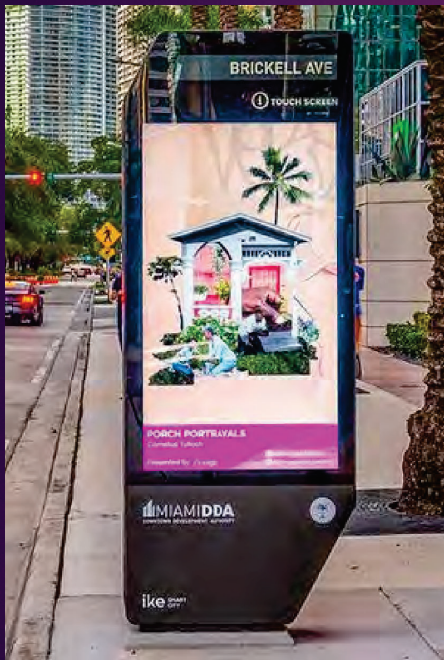
- Bus Benches
- Bus Shelters
- Waste Disposal Receptacles
- Public Pay Telephone
- Street Light Poles
- **Modular Newsracks**

- Official Traffic Control Signs
- Official Markers
- **Specific Information Panels**

# Conclusion

- ▶ Kiosk Advertising Machines are illegal in the State of Florida.
- ▶ Kiosk Advertising Machines playing illegal ads are even more illegal.
- ▶ They are not “modular newsracks” or “specific information panels.”
- ▶ They are not allowed under the City’s Newsrack Ordinance.
- ▶ The City May Not Approve the Installation of Illegal Kiosk Advertising Machines.
  
- ▶ Even if they were legal . . .
  - ▶ The proposed dimensions, placement, and generic design of the Kiosk Advertising Machines make them incompatible with the City’s unique aesthetic.
