




Resilient Florida Program Manager Discussion:

If the Fire Station must be moved, as long as it's still in a "Central South Beach" location, there would be no issue. Voter Referendum

The Miami-Dade County Elections Department has provided the City Clerk with the estimate of approximately \$28,747.40 (cost estimate for a one-page ballot) and \$56,041.70 (cost estimate in the scenario multiple questions triggers an additional page) to conduct a November 5 2024 Special Election.

Additionally, the City will incur approximately \$42,000 in legally mandated advertisements, required by the Florida Statutes and the City Code to notice this special election. An August special election would have similar costs.
