

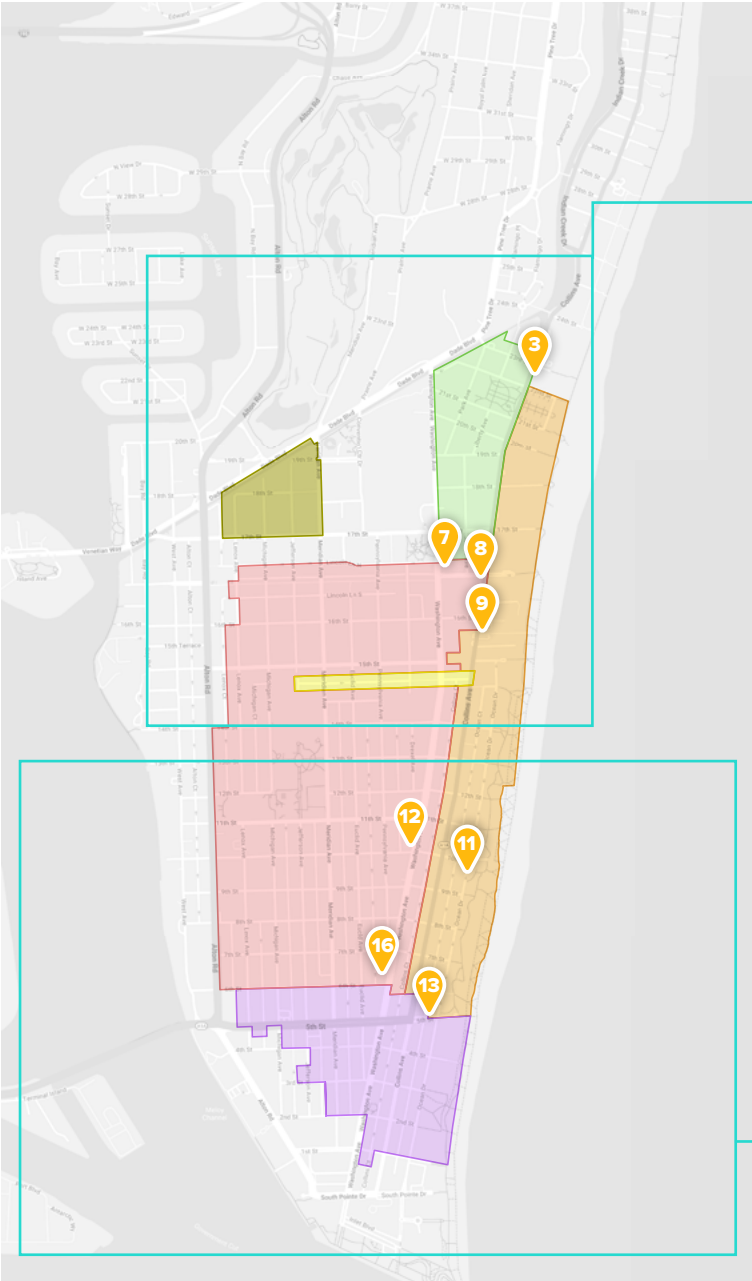

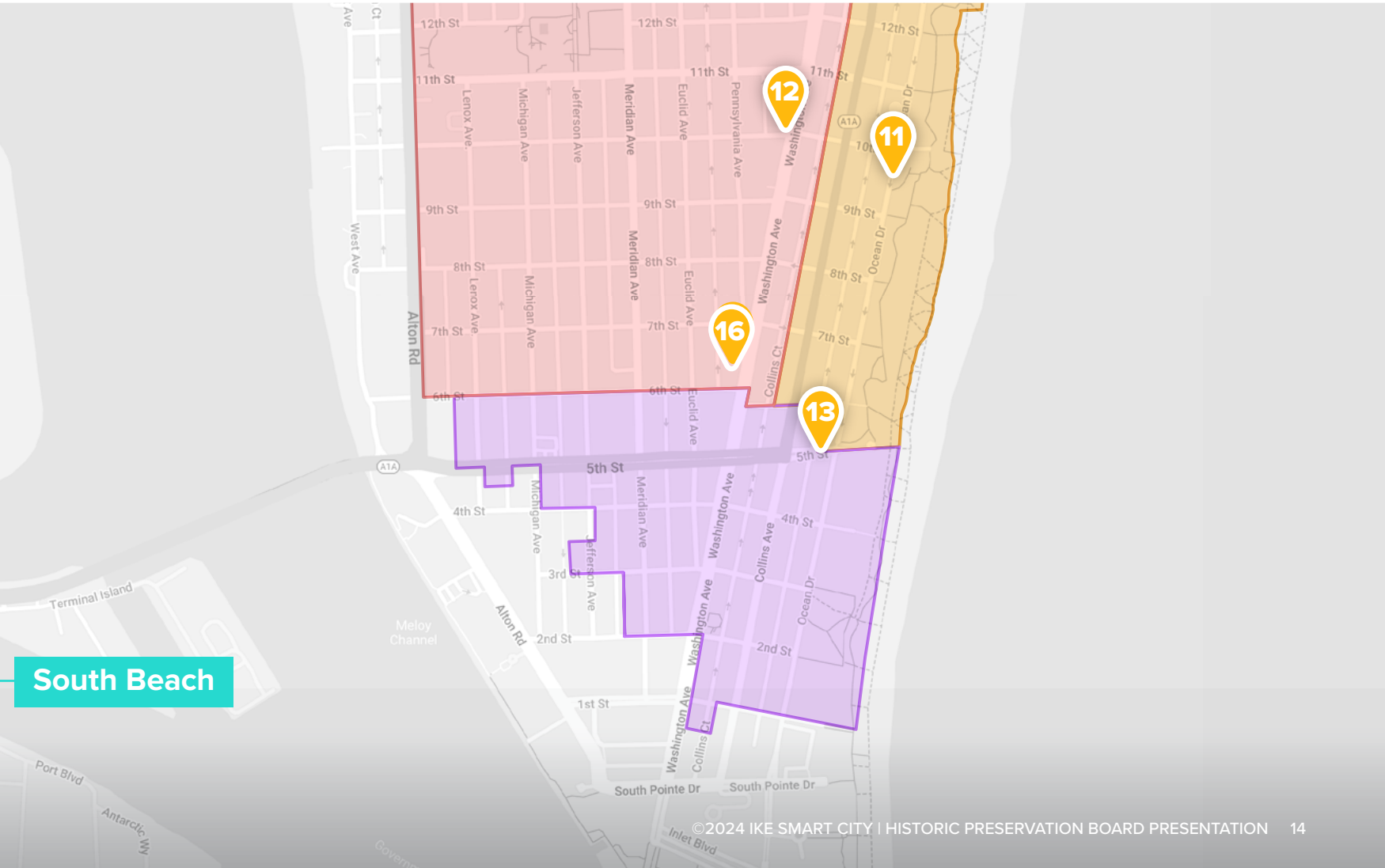
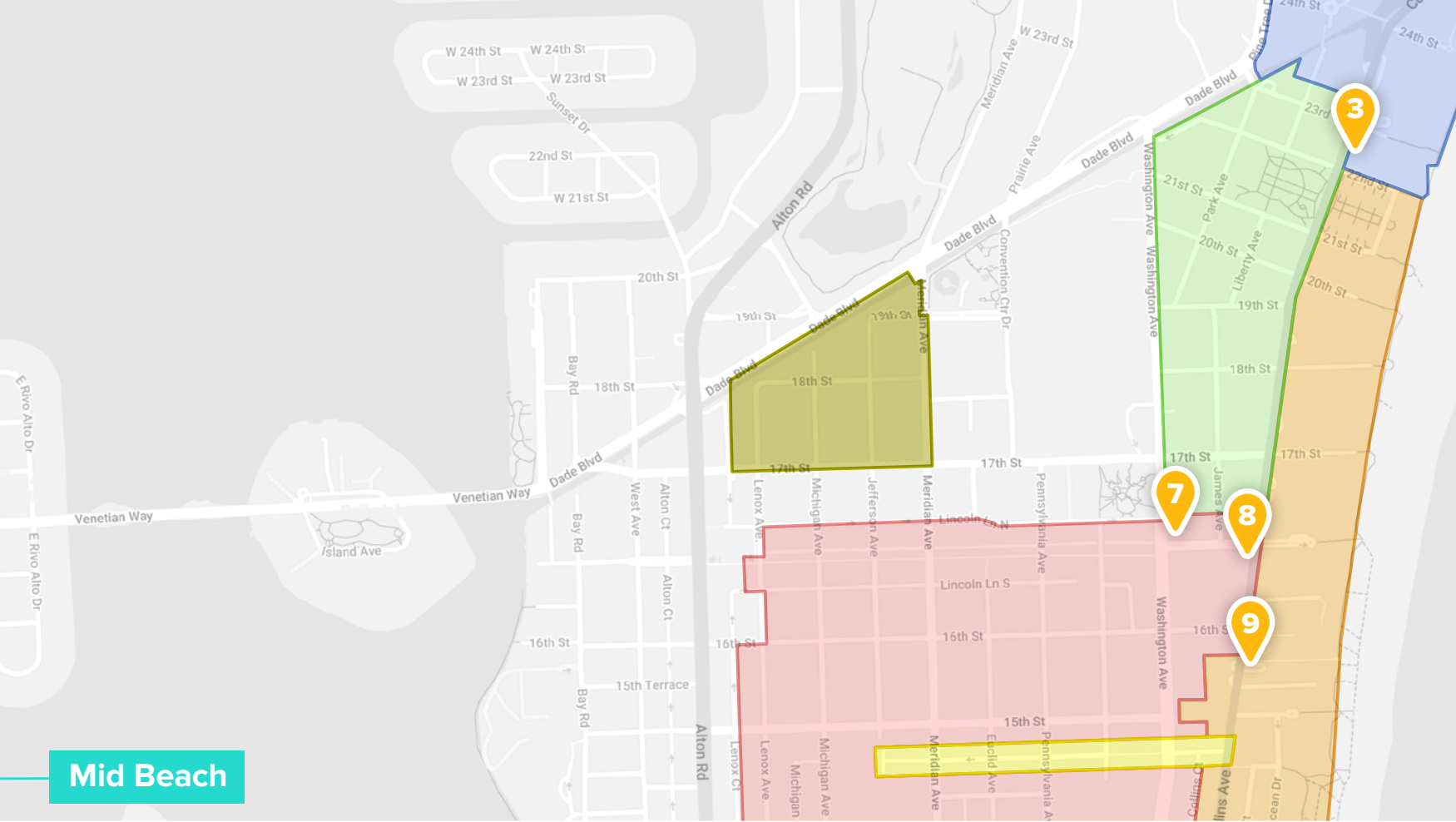

PROPOSED IKE KIOSK LOCATIONS

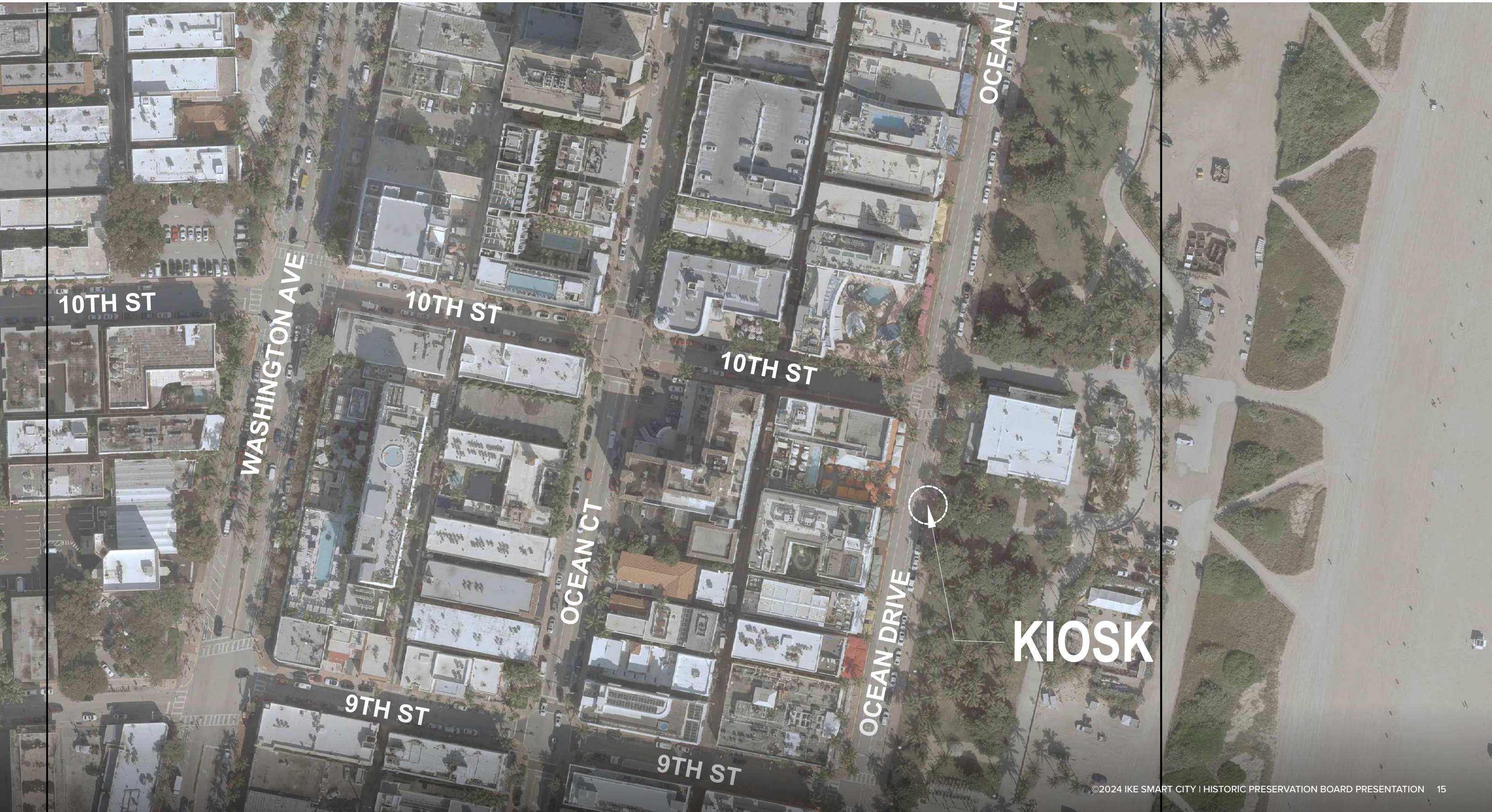
Please see below for the 8 kiosks that are proposed within Historic District boundaries.



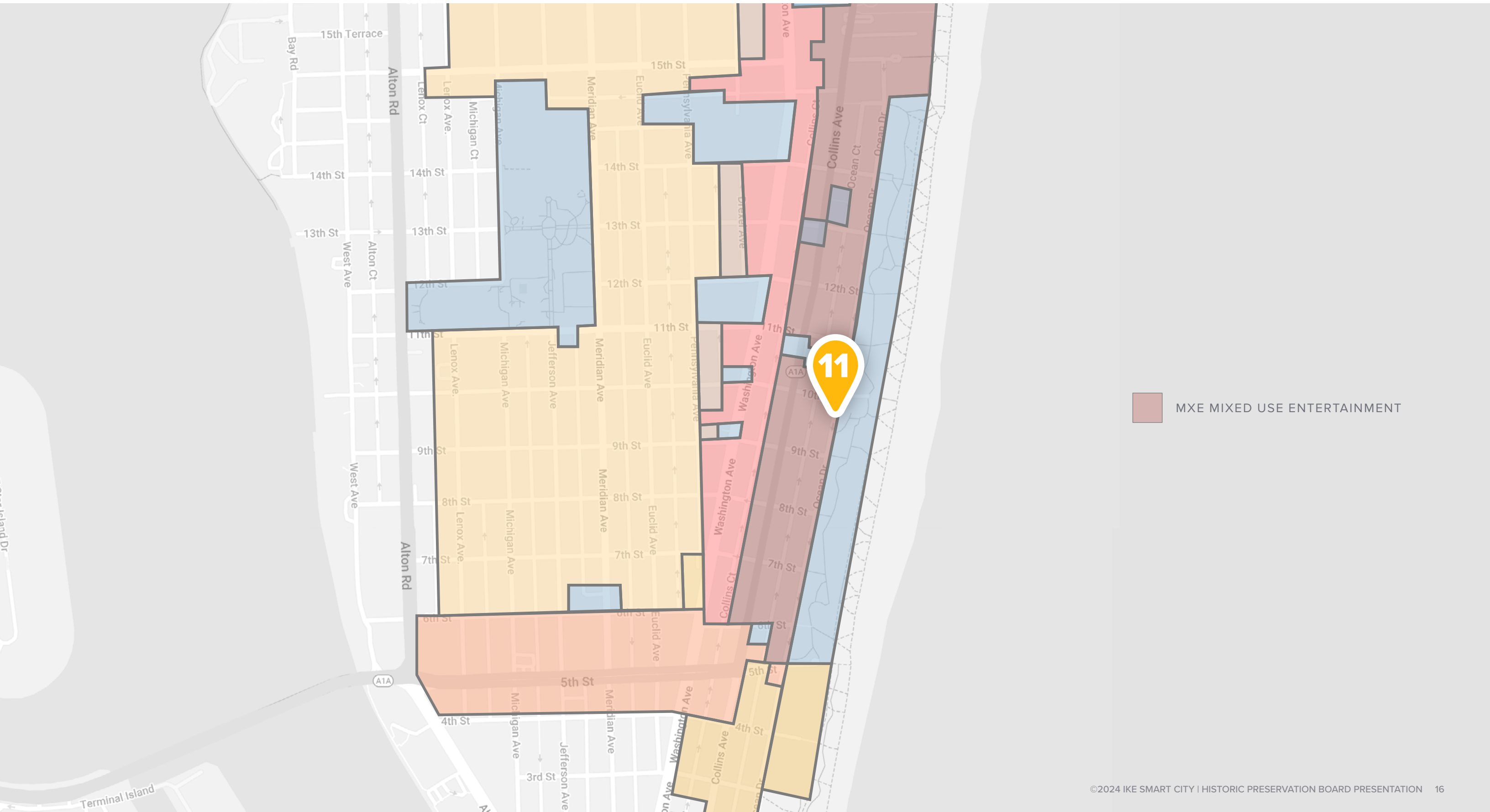

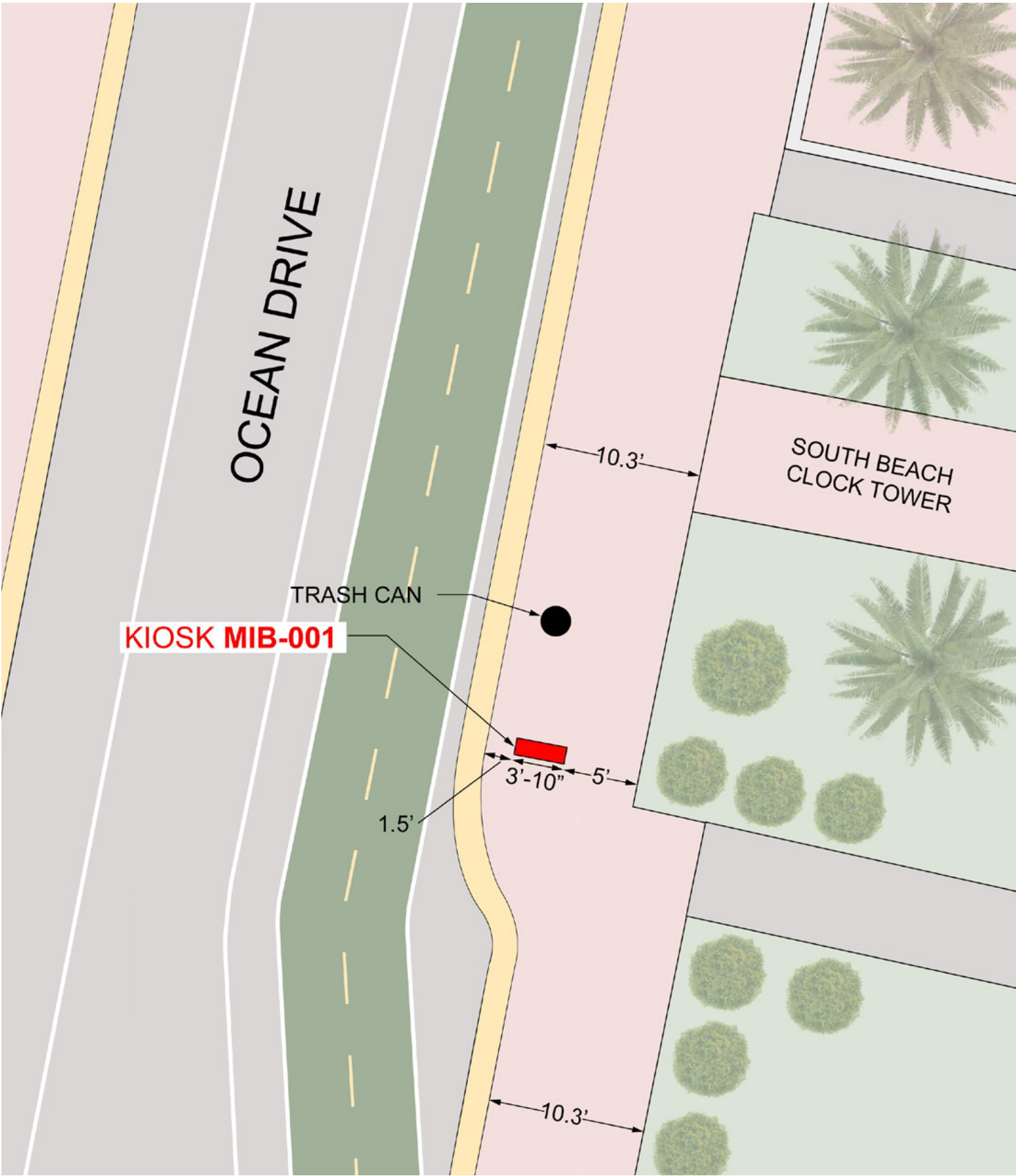


11. OCEAN DR & 10TH ST - KIOSK COLOR RECOMMENDATION

- Historic District: Ocean Drive/Collins Avenue
- Nearest bus stop/shelter: 730'
- Nearest building: 98', Art Deco Welcome Center

11. OCEAN DR & 10TH ST - LOCATION CONSIDERATIONS

TECHNICAL FEASIBILITY

- ▶ Position of kiosk was shifted to avoid South Beach Clock Tower
- ▶ Sidewalk maintains a pedestrian clear walking path of 5'
- ▶ Nearby existing sidewalk features allow adequate space on either side of the kiosk for ADA compliance

ENGAGEMENT AND POINTS OF INTEREST

- ▶ Pedestrian count for this location is 14,281
- ▶ Kiosk is on iconic Ocean Drive near numerous hotels, restaurants, shopping, parks, and beach access
- ▶ Kiosk is adjacent to the Art Deco Welcome Center and Lummus Park

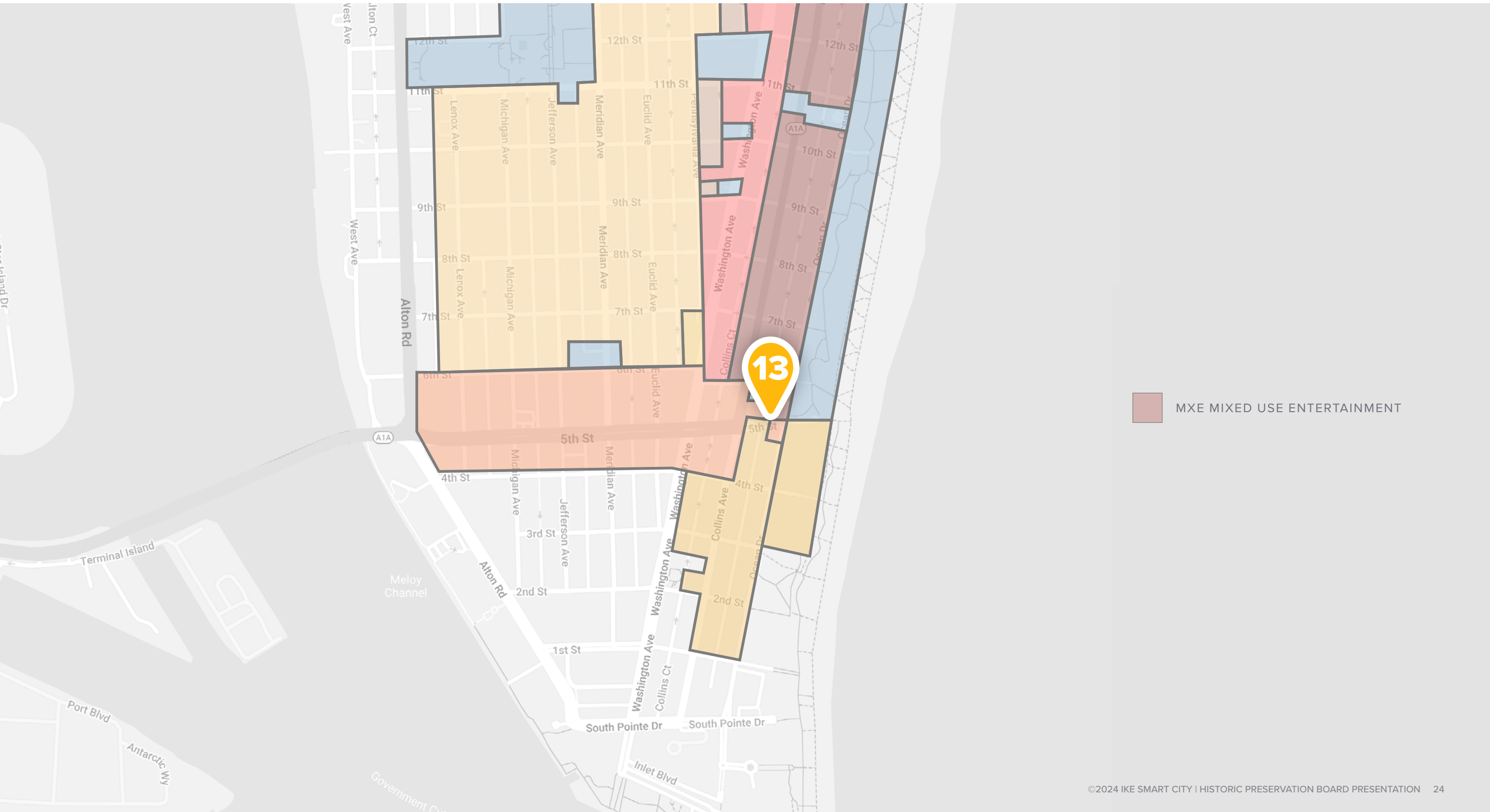

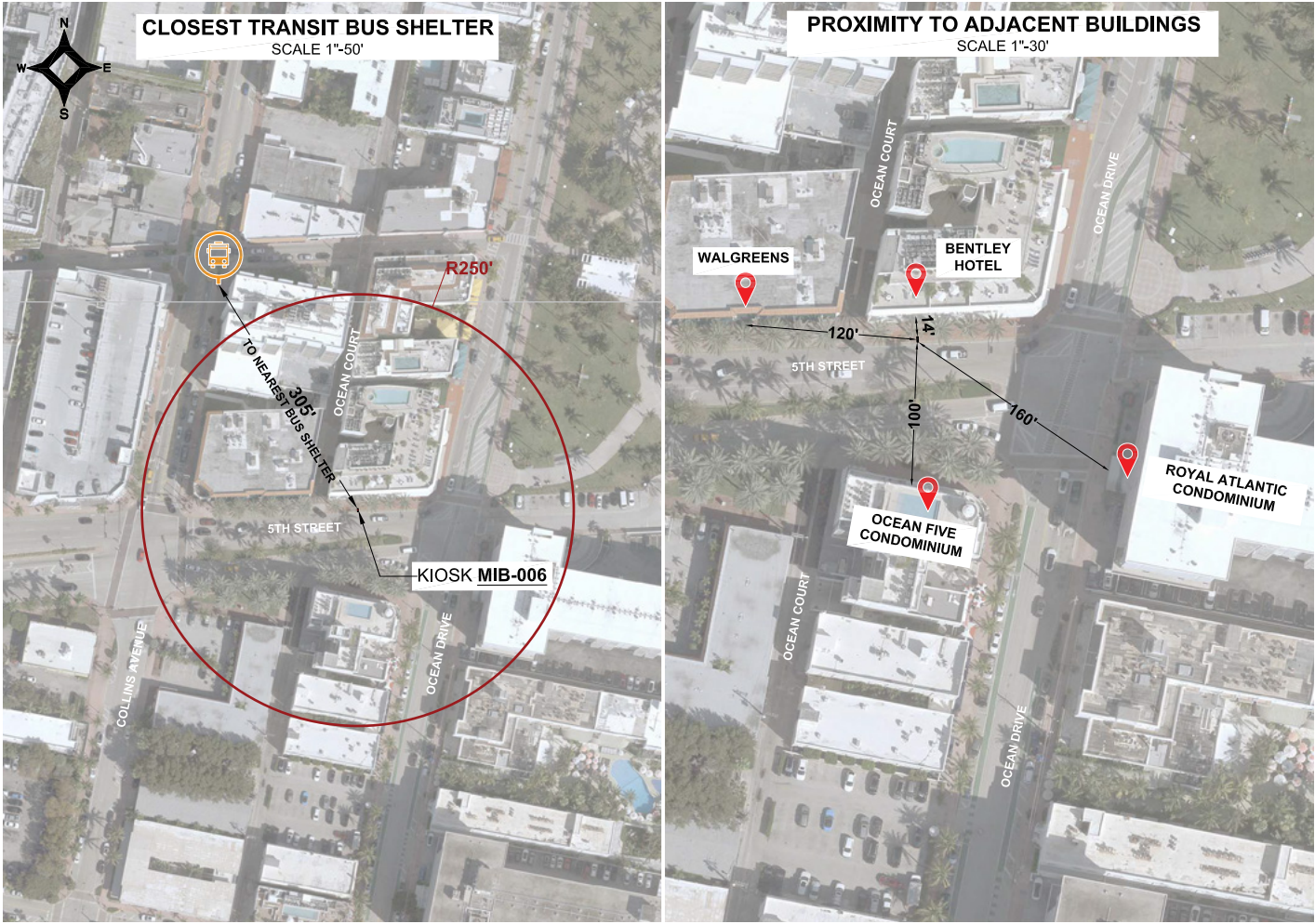
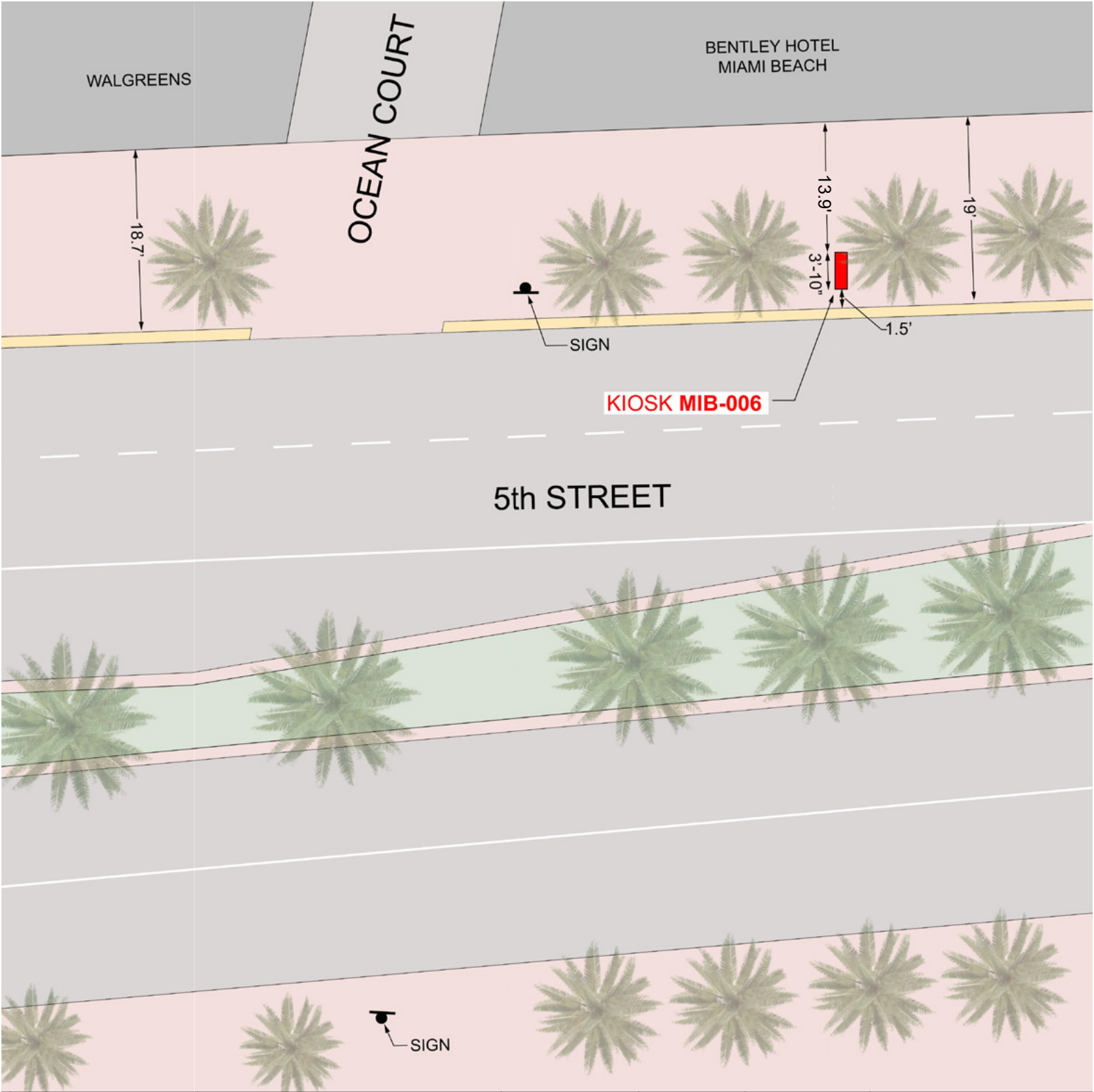


13. OCEAN DR & 5TH ST - KIOSK COLOR RECOMMENDATION

- Nearest building: 14', Bentley Hotel

13. OCEAN DR & 5TH ST - LOCATION CONSIDERATIONS

TECHNICAL FEASIBILITY

- ▶ Sidewalk maintains a pedestrian clear walking path of 13' 9"
- ▶ Nearby existing sidewalk features allow adequate space on either side of the kiosk for ADA compliance

ENGAGEMENT AND POINTS OF INTEREST

- ▶ Pedestrian count for this corner is 12,320
- ▶ Kiosk is nearby to popular hotels, restaurants, and shopping along Ocean Drive
- ▶ Kiosk is strategically placed to connect Collins Ave & Ocean Dr and is at the ride-share pickup point during pedestrian-only access to Ocean Dr
