



Subject: Referral to the Planning Board regarding an Ordinance amending the hours of operation for alcoholic beverage establishments in the Sunset Harbour neighborhood

Pursuant to the request of Commissioner Ricky Arriola, the following item has been placed on the June 7, 2017 City Commission meeting agenda, as a referral to the Planning Board:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 142, "ZONING DISTRICTS AND REGULATIONS," ARTICLE II, "DISTRICT REGULATIONS," (1) AT DIVISION 5, "CD-2 COMMERCIAL, MEDIUM INTENSITY DISTRICT," SECTION 142-310, "SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS"; AND (2) AT DIVISION 11, "I-1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT," SECTION 142-488, "SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS," TO ELIMINATE ANY EXISTING EXCEPTIONS TO THE 2:00 A.M. CLOSING TIME FOR ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE SUNSET HARBOUR NEIGHBORHOOD, GENERALLY BOUNDED BY PURDY AVENUE, 20TH STREET, ALTON ROAD, AND DADE BOULEVARD; AND PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, RÉPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Due to the multiple instances of violent crime that took place over the 2017 Memorial Day Weekend, the sponsor has requested that this Ordinance be referred directly to the Planning Board.
