**Subject:** Referral to the Planning Board regarding an Ordinance amending the hours of operation for alcoholic beverage establishments located on Ocean Drive

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Pursuant to the request of Mayor Philip Levine, the following item has been placed on the June 7, 2017 City Commission meeting agenda, as a referral to the Planning Board:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBPART B OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, ENTITLED "LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS," CHAPTER 142, "ZONING DISTRICTS AND REGULATIONS," ARTICLE II, "DISTRICT REGULATIONS," DIVISION 13, "MXE MIXED USE ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT," TO CREATE SECTION 142-551 THEREOF, ENTITLED "ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS," TO TERMINATE THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS LOCATED ON OCEAN DRIVE AT 2:00 A.M. EVERY NIGHT, EXCEPT FOR INDOOR PORTIONS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS THAT ARE COMPLETELY ENCLOSED AND LOCATED ENTIRELY WITHIN HOTELS; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Due to the multiple instances of violent crime that took place over the 2017 Memorial Day Weekend, the sponsor has requested that this Ordinance be referred directly to the Planning Board.
