Vice-Mayor Dominguez stated that this proclamation is to raise awareness in regard to family abduction.

Proclamation Reads:

WHEREAS The City of Miami Beach recognizes that family abduction is a devasting and traumatic experience that affects countless families across the nation often resulting in emotional distress and long-term consequences for both the abducted children and their loved ones; and,

WHEREAS A family abduction occurs when a child is taken, wrongfully retained, or concealed by a parent or other family member depriving another individual of their right to custody or visitation, even in cases with vague or absent court orders; and a family abduction is often an act of frustration by the perpetrator with the left-behind parent, the legal system, or his or her own situation in life; and,

WHEREAS As the City of Miami Beach strives to remain vigilant and informed about the dangers that face children within our communities, it is critical to recognize that family abduction is a serious crime in all 50 states – not only a civil matter; and law enforcement officers should recognize these events not as harmless offenses, but instead as an insidious form of child abuse; and,

WHEREAS It is incumbent on law enforcement agencies to maintain written plans which specify actions and procedures for promptly meeting situations of alleged family abduction; and courts have held that law enforcement is responsible for making certain that the child is with the person who has lawful custody and must verify the validity of any court orders, and when an agency fails to identify a need for training and to set policy for matters which are foreseeable, it creates a threat to public health; and,

WHEREAS We urge all residents, visitors, and boaters to take this opportunity to review safety guidelines, ensure proper equipment is on board, and always wear a life jacket while enjoying our beautiful waterways; and,

NOW THEREFORE, DO WE, as Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Miami Beach, hereby proclaim May 17th, 2024, as Family Abduction Awareness Day in the City of Miami Beach.

This proclamation is celebrating the anniversary of the modern State of Israel, but there have been Jewish people in Israel for about 3,000 years. Commissioner Fernandez introduced the item and noted that Cuban Independence Day was on May 20, 2024. He recalled his family's history of leaving Cuba after the Cuban Revolution for a better life in the United States.

Proclamation read:

WHEREAS May 20th marks the celebration of Cuban Independence Day, commemorating the island nation's declaration of independence and establishment as a free republic; and

WHEREAS The City of Miami Beach recognizes the deep cultural and historical ties between the Cuban community and our city, honoring the significant contributions of Cuban Americans to our society; and

WHEREAS Despite the joyous nature of this day, it is overshadowed by the persistent issues of repression and human rights violations inflicted by the communist regime in Cuba, mirroring the darkest periods of history experienced by various other minority groups; and

WHEREAS This day reminds us of the collective struggle against injustice faced not only by Cubans but also mirrored in the antisemitic attacks against Jews, the systemic violence and discrimination against the LGBTQ+ community, the enduring racism against Black individuals, and the broader aggression against all minorities seeking freedom and equality; and

WHEREAS The City of Miami Beach stands as a beacon of diversity, inclusion, and respect for human rights, staunchly opposing any form of discrimination and repression, and hereby calls for the freedom and liberation of Cuba from tyranny and oppression.

NOW THEREFORE, DO WE, as Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Miami Beach, hereby proclaim May 20 2024 as CUBAN INDEPENDENCE DAY in the City of Miami Beach.
